_Banks

Pad Bank Bank-/Bank+ buttons
A, B, C, D and DAW bank

_Pads

Finger Drumming Pad#1 to #12
*DAW bank : launch clips in Live, use the sequencer in FL etc.
 You can customise the MIDI Channel, Pad color, MIDI CCs, notes
 etc.*

_Transposition

Octaves Oct-/Oct+ buttons
 Semitones Transp-/Transp+ buttons
 Reset Both Oct- and Oct+ /
 Transp- and Transp+
You can transpose both octave AND semitones at the same time

_Settings

Finger drumming Pad #1 to #12
*MIDI parts, CC messages, Pad color, Velocity curves, Program
 changes etc.
 Deeply customise your KeyLab to make it an extension of yourself*
 Settings menu Settings button
 Direct access Settings button + move an item
*All settings are applied to the currently loaded Program, except
 for the ones in the Global tab*

Program Menu

Program Shortcut Prog button + pad
 Load a program Display buttons
 Edit a program Long-press a display button
*You can add up to 6 User Programs. You can't delete or edit the
 Arturia and DAW Programs*

_Commands

Save Quant Undo Redo
*Save, Undo, and Redo are available in both DAW and Arturia
 Programs*

_Display buttons

Buttons #1 to #8 Buttons below the display
Actions depend on the Program or Menu

_Transport control

Loop Rewind Forward Metronome
 Stop Play Record Tap
Control your DAW

_Hold

Hold On/Off Hold button
Holds the notes you play

_Chord

Chord On/Off Chord button
 Create a chord Chord button + up to 16
 keys
 Play/transpose chord Any key when chord is On
 Chord menu Long-press Chord button
 Exit Chord Menu Back button
Strum, voicing, spread or chord preset can be set in the menu

_Scale

Scale On/Off Scale button
 Scale Menu Long-press scale button
 Exit Scale Menu Back button
Root, scale type and custom scale can be set in the menu

_Arpeggiator

Arp On/Off Arp button
 Arp Menu Long-press Arp button
 Exit Arp Menu Back button
Arp parameters can be set in the menu
 Random menu Display button #8
*Explore the generative side of the Arp by applying randomness to
 some parameters
 Or simply roll the dice! Long-press a parameter to reset it or
 long-press the dice to reset everything*
 Go back to the Arp main menu Back button in Random menu

_Hold, Chord, Scale and Arp

You can combine several or all of these features
 for a great musical result
